There is only one President of the United States. This one person must fill a number of different roles at the same time. Sometimes, the failure to perform one duty can lead to failure in another area.

You have a lot of roles as a person – you're a student, a friend, an athlete?, a performer?, a brother, a sister, a co-worker etc. You try to balance it all.

The president has to balance all of his roles, and he has a number of powers to help him do his jobs.


